

QUALIFICATIONS OF A BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBER

- I. Board of Education members must meet the following qualifications:
- a. Must be a qualified voter of the district; that is, a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years of age or older, and not adjudged to be an incompetent; (Note: a convicted felon is barred from running for a seat on a board of education if his or her maximum prison sentence has not expired or if he or she has not been pardoned or discharged from parole.)
  - b. Able to read and write;
  - c. A legal resident of the District for a continuous and uninterrupted period of at least one (1) year prior to the election;
  - d. Are not a current employee of the District;
  - e. The only member of his/her family that is (cannot be a member of the same household) on the school board;
  - f. May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office, including, but not limited to Superintendent, clerk, tax collector, treasurer or librarian, or any employee of the Board; and
  - g. May not have been removed from any school district office within one (1) year preceding the date of appointment or election to the Board.
